 - a. Trustee Report Fred Burley
 - Maintenance renewal projects are on schedule for stuff like new roofs, painting etc.
 - 29,481 students in RVS in January. That is a 238 rise.
 - Approval of budget process with be done by the end of May.
 - Looking at trustee compensation in other places in Alberta to see what other school boards are doing.
 - Approval of locally developed courses.
 - Weighted moving average changes. It is now 30% from this year and 70% of the projection is funded. It is better but not perfect as we are still underfunded by 140 student rather than 300.
 - 7 schools approved this year for RVS.
 - Cochrane christian academy delegate for bussing needed.
 - New superintendent hired Ryan Reid.

- b. Principal's report Shawna Neis
 - Staffing CDA has been hired starting March 17-April 17 due to the other CDA on a leave.
 - PBIS pink shirt day 40 students recognized. Grade 7 leadership led the whole assembly.
 - Student Advisory meeting 35 students came to discuss what is working and what isn't in regards to PBIS. Hoping to meet with them roughly every 6 weeks.
 - Online assembly worked really well. Teachers were able to discuss with the class easily afterwards. Next one is about responsibility.
 - Grade 4, 7, 10 annual Alberta government survey is heading out. Students and parents are to do them. Codes are being sent home with children.
 - Grade 6 had a visit from Mayor Brown March 3. They are learning about municipal government.
 - 26 to 71 EAL (English Additional Language) students. Learned on our PL day how to help enhance their vocabulary.
 - Shawna is retiring. Last day is June 27, 2025.
- c. School council report
 - We have 9,048.04 in our account.
 - May 6 is teacher appreciation.
 - Requests from Shawna Leadership wants to host a dance on March 21 all day. Motion for up to 800.00 on DJ Christie. 2nd Tara
 - Technology We need a cart and 30 devices. 5,000.00 for a cart and 450.00 per device. So approx 13,500.00 Motion 3,500.00 for devices -Christie. 2nd - Roberta
 - Surveillance cameras quote from a couple of years ago 13,500 for interior and exterior. Exterior is priority. We are waiting on a new quote to decide what we will do.
 - Earmarking 100.00 for year end gift, 1,000.00 for teacher appreciation, 1,800.00 for Bulldog bonanza.
 - We have out next Casino in the 4th quarter of this year.
 - Mom's pantry update 2-3 weeks for the orders to pile up. 2 weeks for delivery. We make 35-40% on orders. We have to order over 5,000 for free shipping or else shipping is 500.00. We are going to go ahead with this fundraiser.
