

Good morning, Meadowbrook Parents/Guardians,

Our school team is excited to welcome your child to school tomorrow! You should have received a welcome email yesterday from your child's homeroom teacher. Please find the current bell schedule attached above. I wanted to follow up with some important information about Meadowbrook School.

Student Entry – Entry into the building will be signaled by music playing at 8:00 AM and students may begin to enter, head to their lockers, and head to their first period for our 8:08 AM start. Students will also be responsible for bringing what they need to classes from their lockers and be prepared for the day.

Allergens - We are a “Nut Sensitive” and Scent Aware school. This means that students are asked to avoid bringing foods that contain nuts or nut byproducts and avoid using overwhelming-scented body products.

Water Fountains - Water fountains are available.

- Water bottle filling stations are available in the school.
- Students are strongly encouraged to bring a labeled reusable water bottle each day.

BYOD – Students may bring a laptop/tablet device if they have one. This is not mandatory. Your teacher will let you know when it will be helpful to have it at school.

Computer Use Guidelines - Students will adhere to RVS Technology Use Agreements.

Cell Phones – Kept in lockers during class time. Cell phones are to be always kept in lockers except for lunch recess.

Shoes – Students are required to have appropriate running shoes for all PE classes.

Gym Strip – Students will be changing for PE. Every student needs a set of gym clothes to change into. You can bring something from home or purchase Meadowbrook Gear if you choose.

Backpacks – Backpacks need to be stored in lockers to keep classrooms clear.

Student Dress Code - Meadowbrook School is a learning and business environment. All members of the school community are expected to meet reasonable standards of dress in keeping with the atmosphere of the school.

The following guidelines should assist you:

- Images and messages on clothing must be appropriate. Clothing will not promote alcohol, drugs, violence, racism, sexism, or any form of intolerance.
- We encourage students to dress comfortably and appropriately. Excessive skin exposure is not appropriate in a learning environment.
- Please note that any student who is unsuitably attired will be required to change into acceptable clothing or return home to change prior to re-admittance to the school.

Lunch – Students eat lunch in their homeroom classroom.

- If staying at school for lunch, students will eat in their classroom at their desks during the first part of lunch – students are responsible to clean up after themselves.
- If your child is going home for lunch, students are gone for the whole time and will return to the front doors to be let in at the end of the lunch hour. Students cannot be on school property if they have gone home for lunch.
- Students going home for lunch need to fill out the online form.
- Microwaves will not be available (for health reasons).

We are looking forward to having a fantastic year and will hopefully be able to meet you in person when we host our Open House on Wednesday, September 21st. You will have the opportunity to meet your child's teachers and take a tour of the school between 4:30 and 6:30 PM so please mark that date on your calendars!
